Declaration of Interest

3. <u>The Chairman</u> expressed a sincere vote of thanks to Prof Francis CHAN for his tremendous contributions to the HA Board in the past 11 years, and HA looked forward to his continued support to HA in serving the community after his retirement from the HA Board on 1 February 2024.

Welcome Remarks

4. <u>The Chairman</u> welcomed the six sit-in colleagues, who were attachees from the Medical, Nursing and Allied Health Grades under the Corporate Exposure Programme of the HA Head Office.

Confirmation of Minutes

5. The draft minutes of the last Administrative & Operational Meeting (AOM) held on 21 December 2023 were confirmed without amendment.

Matters Arising

6. There was no outstanding item arising from the minutes of the last meeting.

Enhancement on Locum Recruitment(Confidential AOM Paper No.1926)

(The subject was discussed and <u>Members</u> approved the proposed new rank of Consultant Specialist (Locum) and the corresponding revision of the pay package of locum specialists in HA. The detailed deliberations were separately recorded in paragraphs 7 to 10.)

Incorporation of the Hospital Authority Body Corporate (EH Plus Digital Technology Limited) (Confidential AOM Paper No.1927)

(The subject was discussed and the detailed deliberations were separately recorded in paragraphs 11 to 16.)

Annual Report on Sentinel and Serious Untoward Events (AOM Paper No.1928)

- 17. <u>Dr Nicole CHAU</u> outlined the Annual Report on Sentinel and Serious Untoward Events from October 2022 to September 2023 in HA, the ongoing risk reduction measures and the new initiatives planned for 2024 to enhance surgical safety, medication safety, infusion pump risk reduction and tourniquet safety in particular. Details were set out in the paper and the slides distributed to Members.
- 18. During the reporting period, there were a total of 19 Sentinel Events (SEs) and 78 Serious Untoward Events (SUEs) reported in HA. The 19 reported SEs were equivalent to the SE incident rate of 0.9 SE per 1 000 000 episodes of patient attendances / discharges and deaths. It was noted that the SUE incident rate had remained relatively stable, and the SE incident rate had reached a ten-year low. "Retained instruments or other material after surgery / interventional procedure" remained the most prevalent category of SE cases (74%).
- 19. <u>Dr Nicole CHAU</u> informed Members that according to the latest categorisation of one SE case, the number of "death of an in-patient from suicide (including home leave)" was revised from three (as set out in paragraph 10 of the paper) to four, representing a suicide rate of 0.21 (instead of 0.16 as stated in the paper) per 100 000 in-patient admissions.
- 20. In reply to Prof David SHUM's enquiry on similar reporting in other countries for benchmarking, <u>Dr Nicole CHAU</u> said that information on international SE reporting was included in the full Annual Report on SE and SUE to be published.
- 21. <u>Members</u> noted the SE and SUE report, the ongoing risk reduction measures and the way forward.
