




Hong Kong Healthcare System in Hong Kong




Healthcare Structure in Hong Kong

- A statutory body tasked to manage all public hospitals & institutions
- Key provider of public-funded healthcare services for > 7 million population







City declares 'protracted war' on flu until May

Hong Kong's public hospitals are bracing for a rush of patients today after the Lunar New Year holiday, with the official in charge declaring a "protracted war" against influenza that could last until the end of May.

Hospital Authority chief executive Dr Leung Pak-yin warned of the fight ahead as the dean of Chinese University's medical school, in separate comments, likened overcrowded public hospital wards to "wet markets" and "battlefields", after visiting one with his students.

Secretary for Food and Health Professor Sophia Chan Siu-chee vesterday said more patients were likely to show up at hospitals in the coming days, now that the four-day festival break was over.

The health minister said she would meet experts from the city's two medical schools to discuss research on flu.

"We hope to see how we can improve our research work. We would also like to understand local data for better flu prevention work," she said.


Meanwhile, Chinese Univer-

sity medical school dean Professor Francis Chan Ka-leung wrote in an article that the scene at public hospital wards was similar to "wet markets" and "battlefields".

"Every corner was filled with temporary beds. Even sinks for hand washing along the corridors were blocked by beds," he wrote. "Staff in wards were very busy and had to handle emergency cases, distribute medication, take care of patients' needs, provide explanations to patients' relatives and fill in hospital admission or discharge records at the same time."

Since the start of the year to Sunday, 14 children were reported to have severe flu and two of them died. A two-year-old boy, who was the latest reported child case, remained in a serious condition vesterday at United Christian Hospital. From January 7 to last Wednesday, 287 adults were reported sick with severe flu and 172 of them died.
