Update on Employment (Amendment) Ordinance 2022 and Proposed Updates to Human Resources Policies Manual (Confidential AOM Paper No.1781)

(This subject was discussed and <u>Members</u> noted the implementation of the Employment (Amendment) Ordinance 2022 (the Amendment Ordinance) regarding sickness allowance and employment protection under anti-epidemic measures as gazetted and effected on 17 June 2022, and approved the proposed changes to HA's Human Resources (HR) policies to correspond with the Amendment Ordinance, as well as the proposed updates to HR Policies Manual (HRPM) in respect of the minimum leave taking requirement in HA. Career Ladder Review for Allied Health Professionals (Confidential AOM Paper No.1783)
