Welcome Remarks

<u>The Chairman</u> extended a warm welcome to Prof ZHANG Zhang-jin and Mr Matthew KWOK, who had joined the Hospital Authority (HA) Board since 1 April 2024, for attending the Administrative & Operational Meeting (AOM) for the first time.

2. <u>The Chairman</u> also welcomed the five sit-in colleagues, who were attachees from the Nursing, Allied Health and Administrative disciplines under the Corporate Exposure Programme of the HA Head Office (HO).

Declaration of Interest

3. <u>The Chairman</u> invited Members to declare conflict of interest, if any, arising from the agenda items of, or discussion at, the meeting. There was no declaration from Members.

Confirmation of Minutes

4. The draft minutes of the last AOM held on 21 March 2024 were confirmed without amendment.

Matters Arising

Membership of Hospital Governing Committees (Paragraphs 18-23 of the minutes of the meeting on 29 February 2024 and paragraphs 6-7 of the minutes of the meeting on 21 March 2024)

5. <u>Ms Natalia LI</u> reported that following the Board's approval on 29 February 2024 and 21 March 2024 of the appointments / re-appointments to various Hospital Governing Committees (HGCs) for the membership term commencing on 1 April 2024, two nominations were received from the HGCs of Cheshire Home, Shatin (SCH) and Hong Kong Red Cross Blood Transfusion Service (BTS) to fill the vacancies arising from the retirement of members of the respective HGCs. Details were set out in the presentation slides distributed to Members.

6. <u>Members</u> approved the following appointments to the respective HGCs with effect from the date of the approval of the Board to 31 March 2025 in line with the progressive terms of appointment under the six-year rule :

 (a) Dr TSE Man-chung (謝文忠博士) nominated by HA as Member of SCH HGC, vice the retirement of Dr Victor LUI Wing-cheong; and (b) Ms Titania WOO Chi-kwan (胡志君女士) nominated by the parent body as Member of BTS HGC, vice the retirement of Ms Dora LI Yuen-chow.

Proposed Establishment of Advisory Committee on Donation and Development Matters (Restricted AOM Paper No.1950)

(The subject was discussed and <u>Members</u> approved the proposed establishment of the Advisory Committee on Donation and Development Matters under the HA Board. The detailed deliberations were separately recorded in paragraphs 7-14.)

Update on Service Sustainability in Ophthalmology – The Rising Demand for Cataract Operations in the Hospital Authority (Restricted AOM Paper No.1951)

(The subject was discussed and <u>Members</u> noted the post-implementation review for the Team-based Piece Rate Remuneration Scheme for Cataract Operations (PRRS) which was on a six-month trial basis from October 2023 to March 2024; and approved the proposal on continuing PRRS for 11 months from May 2024 to March 2025 and the proposed delegation of authority to the Directors' Meeting to review and approve subsequent continuation beyond March 2025. The detailed deliberations were separately recorded in paragraphs 15-20.)
