

New e-Learning Module on Antibiotic Prescription

To tackle antimicrobial resistance (AMR), one of the key areas is proper use of antibiotics. Besides the existing Antibiotic Stewardship Programme (ASP), we would like to introduce a brand new e-learning programme on antibiotic prescription, both of which aim to optimize clinicians' practice of antibiotic use.

Infectious Disease Control Training Centre (IDCTC) and the ASP Working Group have jointly developed an e-learning module that allows clinicians to quickly recap the principles and tips of appropriate antibiotic use in their daily practice. The module is divided into core and optional units. The core unit is intended for clinicians of all specialties while the optional units include surgical prophylaxis, outpatient treatment, serious infections, healthcare-associated, community-acquired and paediatric infection. Doctors may choose suitable units according to their disciplines. Knowledge quiz is provided for each unit. The module is launched today (23 Dec 2019).
