Hospital Visiting Arrangement under Emergency Response Level
Notes to Visitors

1. Starting from 25 March 2023, visitors are **no longer** required to present any proof of COVID-19 testing result before entering the wards.
2. Hospital visits will be arranged **according to the visiting sessions and time of each ward**, without a prior appointment. Subject to the situation in ward, **up to two visitors** can enter the ward **at the same time** for each patient. Exchange of visitors is allowed.
3. All visitors should comply with the following infection control measures:
 - (i) Wear surgical mask within hospital premises all the time;
 - (ii) Eating or drinking should be prohibited during visit; and
 - (iii) Perform hand hygiene before and after visiting hospital.
4. People **NOT permitted** for hospital visit include those:
 - (i) Having fever, cough, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, runny nose, diarrhoea, shortness of breath, breathing difficulties, rash or conjunctivitis; or
 - (ii) Children under 12.
5. Pregnant women are **NOT recommended** for hospital visit.
