- (a) 4 Core Subjects, with English Language and Chinese Language at Level 3 or above, Mathematics at Level 2 or above, and an attainment at "Attained" in Citizenship and Social Development[#]; and
- (b) 1 Elective Subject from Category A New Senior Secondary Subjects at Level 2 or above.
- *For candidates who took Liberal Studies in 2023/24 or before, Level 2 or above in Liberal Studies will be regarded as "Attained" in Citizenship and Social Development.
- 2. Fluency in both written English and Chinese, and spoken English and Cantonese.
