



## Inpatient Information for Emergency Medicine Ward

- This Emergency Medicine Ward is a mixed female and male ward, provides inpatient monitoring and treatment services. Fees will be charged according to Hospital Authority's scheme.
- All patients in Emergency Medicine Ward are under the care of Emergency Medicine Specialists.
- If necessary, patients will be transferred to other specialty ward for continuous treatment.
- Patient should notify ward staff before leaving the ward. Ward nurses would assess patient's condition for such request. Patients leaving without informing ward staff will be classified as missing persons. Family members will be notified and the case may also be reported to the Police.
- If patient has not presented valid proof of identity during his/her registration at Accident and Emergency Department and upon admission, please bring back patient's original identification document as soon as possible to update patient particulars.

## Points to Note

### Visiting Hours

- 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily
- Each patient will only be allowed 2 visitors at the bed side at any one time. Children under the age of 12 are generally not allowed into the ward area unless prior permission by ward nurse in-charge is obtained.
- The visiting arrangement may be adjusted. Visitors can refer to the notice posted outside the ward for particular visiting hours.
- Visitors may be advised to wait outside the ward area if emergency procedures are being carried out. We apologize for the inconvenience caused.

### Facilities

- Male & Female Washrooms – Near the ward entrance and the end of the ward.
- Call Bell – Available at each bed for use. Don't leave the bed by yourself if you are feeling dizzy or having difficulties in walking. Please inform ward staff for assistance if needed.

### Request to meet doctors

- Please contact ward nurses for appointment if you wish to discuss with the case doctor.

### Patient Catering

- Dishes are carefully designed to be nutritionally balanced and healthy.

- For patients requiring special diet as part of the treatment, relatives or friends are advised not to bring food to the patients for the sake of achieving desirable treatment result.

### Security & Safety

- Patients are advised not to bring personal belongings or valuables into the hospital.
- Please do not bring sharps or dangerous objects such as knives, scissors or lighters.
- Smoking is prohibited in hospital premises (including washrooms).
